I. STATEMENT

1. On November 5, 2004, N.E. Colorado Cellular, Inc., doing business as Viaero (NECC) filed an Unopposed Motion for Extension of Time to File Answer Testimony (Motion) in the captioned matter.

2. The Motion seeks an extension of time, from November 5, 2004, to November 9, 2004, for NECC to submit its answer testimony in this matter. *See*, Decision No. R04-1180-I. As grounds therefore, NECC notes the extension of time granted to the Petitioner, Willard Telephone Company (Willard), to file its direct testimony and states that granting its extension request would preserve the previously established interval between the filing deadline for Willard's direct testimony and its answer testimony. *See*, Decision No. R04-1257-I.

3. The Motion indicates that Willard does not oppose the relief requested therein.

4. Good grounds having been shown, the Motion will be granted and response time thereto will be waived.

II. ORDER

A. It Is Ordered That:

1. The Unopposed Motion for Extension of Time to File Answer Testimony filed by N.E. Colorado Cellular, Inc., is granted and response time thereto is waived.
2. N.E. Colorado Cellular, Inc., shall file its answer testimony and exhibits, in question and answer form, on or before November 9, 2004.
3. This Order shall be effective immediately.
