**I. STATEMENT**

1. On December 10, 2004, Rocky Mountain Access Transportation, Inc. (Applicant), through its counsel, Richard J. Bara, Esq., who entered his appearance, filed a Motion for Extension of Time to Complete Compliance Requirements, as ordered in Recommended Decision No. R04-1190. Applicant also requests that response time to the motion be waived.

2. Decision No. R04-1190, granted authority to Applicant. Ordering paragraph no. 6, of the Decision required Applicant to comply with certain matters including filing proof of insurance with the Commission no later than December 13, 2004, unless the deadline was extended by the Commission.

3. Applicant states that it needs additional time to secure proper insurance and to fully comply with the compliance filings ordered in ordering paragraph no. 6. Applicant requests

that it be granted an extension of time to complete compliance filings to and including February 11, 2005.

4. Good cause having been shown, the motion of Applicant will be granted.

## **II. ORDER**

### **A. It Is Ordered That:**

1. The motion of Rocky Mountain Access Transportation, Inc., for an extension of time to complete compliance requirements is granted.

2. Rocky Mountain Access Transportation, Inc., is granted an extension of time to and including February 11, 2005 in which to complete compliance filings ordered in ordering paragraph no. 6 of Decision No. R04-1190.

3. Response time to the motion is waived.

4. This Order is effective immediately.
