The principle proposed change is: to revise the Company's P.U.C. No. 6 - Gas tariff. The Commission revised its Rules Regulating Gas Utilities and Pipeline Operators effective April 1, 2006. All jurisdictional utilities are required to revise their tariffs to come into compliance with Commission rules as soon as possible, pursuant to Decision No. C05-1081.

The Company is revising its Deposit Policy in its General Terms and Conditions section to comply with the Commission's new rules; specifically, Rule 3403(c)(d)(f) and (o)(IV); Applications for Service, Customer Deposits, and Third-Party Guarantee Arrangements. The Company proposes to clarify its credit scoring policy, redefine its deposit requirements, and limit the amount a Guarantor can guarantee on a customer's bill.

Alternative form of notice has been previously approved in Docket No. 06M-294EG, Decision No. C06-0603. Alternative form of notice will be to place a legal notice in The Denver Post and The Rocky Mountain News. A copy of the notice is attached.

This Advice Letter is being contemporaneously filed with Advice Letter No. 1462 - Electric, which will make the same changes to the Company's Electric Tariff.

The effect of this filing on the Company's annual revenue will depend upon the number of customers and the amount of bills impacted by the proposed tariff revisions in this filing.

It is desired that the changed tariff accompanying this advice letter become effective July 31, 2006.
