- 1. This matter comes before the Public Utilities Commission (Commission) for consideration of the Motion for Extension of Time filed by the City of Evans (Evans) on December 19, 2006.
- 2. The Commission ordered Evans to file a signed copy of the construction and maintenance agreement by December 23, 2006 by Decision C06-0870, mailed July 27, 2006.
- 3. Evans states that Union Pacific Railroad (UPRR) has requested additional information and an estimate for the project in order to prepare an appropriate contract. Evans states that Evans and UPRR will need until the end of April to complete the estimates and prepare the appropriate contract documents for submittal to the Commission.
