The purpose of this Advice Letter is to replace the material in Qwest's Local Network Interconnection and Service Resale Tariff, Colorado P.U.C. No. 22, in its entirety. This Advice letter incorporates into P.U.C. No. 22 change in law revisions¹ resulting from the FCC Triennial

Review Order ("TRO"), the Triennial Review Remand Order ("TRRO"), All-or-Nothing Rule Order, Core Forbearance Petition², FTTC (Fiber To The Curb/Home)³, Virginia Arbitration Order⁴, and Subscriber List/Directory Assistance Order⁵. This Advice Letter incorporates changes as well as new products and/or services which have been reviewed and approved by the Change Management Process⁶ and reflects agreements reached with CLECs in other states in the Qwest region through the 271 process. Additionally, clarifying and/or other changes have been made to including, but not limited to, insurance coverage, Customer Proprietary Network Information ("CPNI"), single strand dark fiber availability, wireless listings, directory assistance, operator services and Directory Assistance List⁷. Non-substantive administrative revisions have also been made to correct typographical, grammatical, capitalization, punctuation and spelling errors, and terminology.

Revisions have also been made to Exhibit A (Rates) to correspond with the proposed changes to terms and conditions. Consequently, Exhibit A revisions include 1) rate elements for new products and/or services incorporated into the tariff, 2) restructured rate elements and 3) elimination of certain rate elements. (Refer to red-lined version of Exhibit A for further detail.) Qwest anticipates that these Exhibit A revisions will be addressed in Phase 2 of the wholesale cost docket, and requests that the Commission allow these revisions to become effective pending the outcome of the cost docket.

Finally, this Advice Letter reflects changes to further conform P.U.C. No.22 to a tariff offering. Consequently, Exhibits B (Performance Indicator Definitions), J (Reciprocal Compensation Election), K (Colorado Performance Assurance Plan), L (Advice Adoption Letter), and M (Interim Advice Adoption Letter) have been eliminated and have been intentionally left blank as they are inapplicable in the context of services offered pursuant to a tariff. Exhibit G (Change Management Process) also has been intentionally left blank. Exhibit G is constantly evolving through the Change Management Process and the most-up-to date version is publicly available on Qwest's website at www.qwest.com/wholesale/cmp/index.html.

The above described tariff changes are reflected in a red-lined version attached to this Advice Letter and provided on disk. The changes are footnoted to identify the reason and/or authority for the change.

P.U.C. No. 22 tariff continues to conform to the format requirements set out in Decision No. C02-627 issued by the Commission in Docket No. 02V-248T.


