I. STATEMENT

1. TJM Holdings, LLC, doing business as ATS filed its application for a permit to operate as a contract carrier by motor vehicle for hire on May 19, 2014.

2. MKBS, LLC, doing business as Metro Taxi &/or Taxis Fiesta &/or South Suburban Taxi &/or Northwest Suburban Taxi; Commission Staff; and Colorado Cab Company, LLC, doing business as Denver Yellow Cab, are intervenors by right.

3. By Decision No. R14-0929-I issued August 5, 2014, a hearing was scheduled to be held on October 7, 2014, and procedural matters were addressed.

4. On October 1, 2014, MKBS, LLC, doing business as Metro Taxi's Motion to Dismiss the Application of TJM Holdings, LLC, doing business as ATS was filed. It is requested that response time be shortened based upon the scheduled hearing.

5. Without shortened response time, the motion would not be decided prior to hearing. Based upon good cause shown, and so that the matter may timely be considered, response time to the motion will be shortened to the scheduled commencement of hearing.

II. ORDER

A. It Is Ordered That:

1. Response time to MKBS, LLC, doing business as Metro Taxi's Motion to Dismiss the Application of TJM Holdings, LLC, doing business as ATS filed on October 1, 2014, is shortened.
2. Any party desiring to file a response to the motion shall do so at or before the hearing scheduled to commence in this matter at 9:00 a.m. on October 7, 2014.
