I. BY THE COMMISSION

A. Statement

1. This matter comes before the Commission for consideration of a Motion for Extension of Time (Motion) filed by the City and County of Broomfield (Broomfield) on November 27, 2019, seeking an extension of time to February 29, 2020 to file the final design plans for this application for review and approval by the Commission.

2. As grounds for Motion, Broomfield states that it has been working with its engineers and BNSF Railway Company (BNSF) on the final design plans. However, Broomfield states it does not have sufficient information to complete and file the final design plans and is requesting additional time to finalize the plans. Broomfield requests up to and including February 29, 2020 to file the final design plans for Commission review and approval.

3. No responses were filed to the Motion.

4. Now being fully advised in the matter, we grant the Motion.

II. ORDER

A. The Commission Orders That:

1. The Motion for Extension of Time filed by the City and County of Broomfield (Broomfield) on November 27, 2019 seeking an extension of time to February 29, 2020 to file the final design plans for this application for review and approval by the Commission is granted.

2. Broomfield shall provide the final design plans to the Commission for review by February 29, 2020.

3. The Commission retains jurisdiction to enter further decisions as necessary.
