## I. STATEMENT

- 1. On November 16, 2018, the City of Louisville (Applicant) filed the above-captioned proceeding with the Colorado Public Utilities Commission, seeking an order authorizing the installation of 4-quadrant railroad gates with flashing lights, bells, constant warning time circuitry, and new signal cabin, at the South Boulder Road crossing of BNSF Railway (BNSF or Railroad) tracks in Boulder County, State of Colorado.
- 2. On November 19, 2018, the Commission mailed notice of this Application to all interested parties, including the adjacent property owners identified in the Application.
- 3. During the Commission's weekly meeting held January 3, 2019, the matter was referred to an administrative law judge (ALJ) for disposition.

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4. In anticipation of the hearing, the undersigned ALJ is setting a prehearing

conference in accordance with Rule 1409(a) of the Rules of Practice and Procedure, 4 Code of

Colorado Regulations 723-1.

5. Section 40-4-106(3)(a), C.R.S., and Commission Rule 7208 of the Rules

Regulating Railroads, Rail Fixed Guideways, Transportation by Rail, and Rail Crossings require

notice to be provided to all persons interested in or affected by the grant or denial of the

application, including those interested persons the applicant lists in its application.

6. Rule 7204(a)(I)(K) requires an applicant to identify the owners of property

adjacent to the crossing. The Commission provides notice to the adjacent property owners listed

in the application.

7. Reviewing the Commission's file in this proceeding, it is noted that notices were

returned to the Commission as undeliverable. During the prehearing conference, Applicant

should be prepared to address the names and mailing addresses of those addressees.
