I. BY THE COMMISSION

A. Statement

1. On December 23, 2020 Mission:data Coalition, Inc. (Mission:data) filed its Motion to Reopen, Join Proceedings, Establish a Procedural Schedule, Extend the Deadline for Filing Responses, And for an Order Prohibiting Public Service Company of Colorado From Temporarily Deploying Certain Advanced Meter Software Applications. The relief requested in the Motion is sweeping, and Mission:data indicates that a number of stakeholders intend to file responses to its Motion. Accordingly, on its own motion the Commission hereby extends the deadline to file responses to Mission:data's Motion to January 15, 2021.

II. ORDER

A. It Is Ordered That:

1. Responses to the Motion to Reopen, Join Proceedings, Establish a Procedural Schedule, Extend the Deadline for Filing Responses, and for an Order Prohibiting Public Service
