I. <u>BY THE COMMISSION</u>

A. Statement, Findings, and Conclusions

1. On October 24, 2024, Rapid Creek Cycles & Sports LLC, doing business as Palisade Plunge Cycle and Shuttle ("Applicant"), filed an application seeking approval to suspend operations under its authority, Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity ("CPCN") PUC No. 55955, for the winter season.

2. By Decision No. C24-0878, issued on November 26, 2024, the Commission granted the unopposed application for a suspension of operations from October 23, 2024, through May 1, 2025.

3. On April 11, 2025, Mr. Rondo Buecheler, the owner of Applicant, submitted a letter, which states the following: "We wish to reinstate [our] PUC Permit #55955 April 20, 2025."

4. The Commission finds good cause to grant this request and lift the suspension of operations under CPCN PUC No. 55955.

II. ORDER

A. The Commission Orders That:

1. The letter filed on April 11, 2025, by Rapid Creek Cycles & Sports LLC, doing business as Palisade Plunge Cycle and Shuttle, requesting that the Commission reinstate Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity PUC No. 55955, is granted.

2. The suspension of operations approved by Decision No. C24-0878 is lifted.

3. Prior to commencing operations, Rapid Creek Cycles & Sports LLC, doing business as Palisade Plunge Cycle and Shuttle, shall: (a) cause proof of insurance or surety bond coverage to be filed with the Commission pursuant to Rule 6008, 4 *Code of Colorado Regulations* ("CCR") 723-6; (b) pay to the Commission the applicable vehicle identification fee for each vehicle to be operated under authority granted by the Commission; and, (c) ensure that an effective tariff is on file with the Commission, in compliance with applicable Commission rules

4. The 20-day time period provided by § 40-6-114(1), C.R.S., to file an Application for Rehearing, Reargument, or Reconsideration shall begin on the first day after the Commission mails or serves this Decision.

5. This Decision is effective immediately upon its Issued Date.
