INTERIM DECISION DENYING STAFF’S MOTION TO CONSOLIDATE AS MOOT

Issued Date: October 9, 2025

I. STATEMENT, FINDINGS, AND CONCLUSIONS

1. Proceeding No. 25G-0336TO concerns Civil Penalty Assessment Notice (“CPAN”) No. 144868 issued by Colorado Public Utilities Commission (“Commission”) Staff (“Staff”) on August 12, 2025 to Respondent Swft Towing LLC (“Swft” or “Respondent”). The CPAN assessed a total penalty of \$2,213.75, inclusive of any surcharge, for five alleged violations of the Commission’s Transportation Rules.¹

2. Proceeding No. 25G-0337TO concerns CPAN No. 144626 issued by Staff on August 12, 2025 to Respondent. The CPAN assessed a total penalty of \$2,530, inclusive of any surcharge, for seven alleged violations of the Commission’s Transportation Rules.²

3. Proceeding No. 25G-0338TO concerns CPAN No. 144762 issued by Staff on August 12, 2025 to Respondent. The CPAN assessed a total penalty of \$1,265, inclusive of any surcharge, for two alleged violations of the Commission’s Transportation Rules.³

4. On September 3, 2025, the Commission referred Proceeding Nos. 25G-0336TO, 25G-0337TO, and 25G-0338TO by minute entry to an administrative law judge (“ALJ”) for disposition.

5. On September 24, 2025, the ALJ issued Decision No. R25-0679-I, which consolidated the proceedings, provided instructions for parties on how to properly prepare the captions for filings in the consolidated cases, identified 25G-0336TO as the primary proceeding, and set the matter for hearing.

6. On September 25, 2025, Staff filed a “Notice of Intervention as of Right, Entry of Appearance, Notice Pursuant to Rule 1007(a) and Rule 1401, and Request for Hearing” in the three separate proceedings.

7. On September 30, 2025, Staff filed a Motion to Consolidate Proceedings and Waive or Shorten Response Time in Proceeding No. 25G-0336TO.

8. The ALJ will deny Staff’s motion as moot. The ALJ consolidated the proceedings in Decision No. R25-0679-I.

II. ORDER

A. It is Ordered That:

9. Colorado Public Utilities Commission Staff’s September 30, 2025 Motion to Consolidate Proceedings and Waive or Shorten Response Time is denied as moot. The ALJ consolidated Proceeding Nos. 25G-0336TO, 25G-0337TO, and 25G-0338TO, and identified Proceeding No. 25G-0336TO as the primary proceeding, in Decision No. R25-0679-I (issued September 24, 2025).

10. Parties must use Proceeding No. 25G-0336TO for all future filings in this consolidated proceeding.

11. This Decision is effective immediately.
