  - 2) Eight hundred dollars (\$800), if any portion of the application requests taxi authority within and/or between the Counties of Adams, Arapahoe, Boulder, Broomfield, Denver, Douglas, El Paso, and Jefferson.
- b) **Certificate of Good Standing:** LLCs and Corporations shall include a Certificate of Good Standing authorizing the applicant to do business in Colorado, issued by the Colorado Secretary of State's Office within 14 days prior to the filing of this application.
- c) **Evidence of Trade Name:** If applicant will operate under a trade name, then Individuals/Sole Proprietors, Partnerships, LLCs, and Corporations shall include a Certificate of Assumed Trade Name or a Certificate of Fact of Trade Name issued by the Colorado Secretary of State's Office.
- d) **Lawful Presence:** Individuals/Sole Proprietors shall attach an original completed Affidavit of Eligibility of Lawful Presence in the United States. (available on the PUC website) (only provide the original, do not make or attach any other copies to the application)
- e) **Letters of Public Support:** Signed letters of public support indicating a public need for the proposed service. A letter from the applicant shall be considered a letter of public support. Those applicants seeking taxi authority within and between the Counties of Adams, Arapahoe, Boulder Broomfield, Denver, Douglas, El Paso, and Jefferson may, but are not required to, attach support letters. A letter of public support:
  - 1) shall contain the author's name, address, and phone number;
  - 2) should explain the public need;
  - 3) should specifically support the applicant's particular request for authority;
  - 4) should describe whether and how existing service is inadequate;
  - 5) shall contain an explanation of the immediate and urgent need for the proposed service; whether there is any other transportation service available; if such service is available, a detailed description of the author's efforts to use it and whether it is capable of meeting the author's needs; and the extent to which available transportation services have refused to provide service;
  - 6) shall contain an explanation of the basis and nature of the emergency need for the proposed service;
  - 7) shall contain a statement that the letter contains only information that is true and correct to the best of the author's knowledge and belief; and
  - 8) shall contain the author's signature; and
- f) **Required Number of Copies:** The original signed application with all supporting documents and **ten** copies of the application and supporting documents.

**20. Applicant Attestation:**

By signing this form, the applicant:

- a) attests that the applicant has read the application and has personal knowledge that the statements in it are true;
- b) attests that the applicant understands that if any portion of the application is found to be false or contain material misrepresentations, any CPCN may be deemed null and void, upon Commission Order;
- c) attests that if the requested authority is granted, the applicant will (1) have its insurance agent file the required certificates of insurance with the Commission (the name on the certificate of insurance must agree exactly with the individual, partnership, corporate, or company name, as well as any trade name); (2) file the necessary tariffs; (3) purchase the appropriate number of vehicle identification stamps;
- d) attests that the applicant understands that the Commission will, in its discretion, cancel any duplicating or overlapping authorities created by granting the application
- e) attests that the applicant will operate in accordance with the Commission's Rules Regulating Transportation By Motor Vehicle; and
- f) attests that the applicant understands that the filing of this application does not constitute authority to operate.
