I. STATEMENT

1. The captioned proceeding was initiated on April 30, 2004, when the Complainant, RDSM Transportation, Ltd., doing business as Yellow Cab Company (RDSM), filed a Formal Complaint with the Colorado Public Utilities Commission (Commission) against Respondent, Samja's Enterprises, Inc., doing business as Express Airport Taxi/Express Taxi (Express Taxi).

2. On May 3, 2004, the Commission issued an Order Setting Hearing and Notice of Hearing setting this matter for hearing on June 17, 2004, at 9:00 a.m. in Denver, Colorado.

3. On May 28, 2004, the June 17, 2004, the hearing date and the procedural schedule applicable to this proceeding were vacated. *See*, Decision No. R04-0572-I. That decision requested that the parties submit advisements concerning their availability for a rescheduled

hearing on or before June 7, 2004. Both RDSM and Express Taxi filed their respective advisements on or before that date.

4. Based on the advisements provided by the parties, it appears that August 23 and 24, 2004, are convenient dates for a re-scheduled hearing. These hearing dates, as well as a procedural schedule governing this proceeding, are adopted by the Order that follows.

II. ORDER

A. It Is Ordered That:

1. This matter is re-scheduled for hearing as follows:

2. Complainant, RDSM Transportation, Ltd., doing business as Yellow Cab Company, shall file its list of witnesses and copies of exhibits on or before August 2, 2004.

3. Respondent, Samja's Enterprises, Inc., doing business as Express Airport Taxi/Express Taxi, shall file its list of witnesses and copies of exhibits on or before August 13, 2004.

4. In accordance with Rule 72(a)(7) of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure, 4 *Code of Colorado Regulations* 723-1-72(a)(7), no witness will be permitted to testify and no exhibit will be received in evidence, except in rebuttal, unless filed and served pursuant to the above requirements. If a party does not meet such requirements, the Commission

may dismiss the complaint or answer upon motion filed by the other party, or upon the Commission's own motion, unless good cause for failure to meet the requirements is shown.

5. This Order shall be effective immediately.
