# INTERIM COMMISSION DECISION ADOPTING CONSENSUS DISCOVERY PARAMETERS AND REFERRING DISCOVERY DISPUTES AND MOTIONS FOR EXTRAORDINARY PROTECTION TO AN ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE

## I. <u>BY THE COMMISSION</u>

### A. Statement, Findings, and Conclusions

- 1. On March 1, 2024, Atmos Energy Corporation (Atmos) filed its initial Gas Infrastructure Plan (GIP). Atmos made the filing consistent with provisions in the Commission's Rules Regulating Gas Utilities, 4 *Code of Colorado Regulations* (CCR) 723-4-4550 to 4555.
- 2. Through Decision No. C24-0259, the Commission required the parties to confer and file proposed discovery parameters ten days after the Commission established the parties to this Proceeding.
- 3. On June 11, 2024, Atmos filed a consensus proposal on discovery parameters. The discovery parameters include a discovery period starting June 28, 2024, and ending August 12, 2024, and that responses to any data requests would be due ten business days after the date of service.

- 4. We find that the discovery procedures proposed by the parties are reasonable, and therefore we adopt the discovery parameters set forth in the consensus proposal.
- 5. Additionally, we refer all discovery disputes and motions for extraordinary protection to the Administrative Law Judge that is scheduling and convening a public comment hearing in this Proceeding.

## II. ORDER

## A. It Is Ordered That:

- 1. The discovery parameters set forth in the consensus proposal filed by Atmos Energy Corporation on June 11, 2024, are adopted.
- 2. All discovery disputes are referred to the Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) that is scheduling and convening a public comment hearing in this Proceeding.
- Motions for extraordinary protection filed in this Proceeding are also referred to the ALJ.

- 4. This Decision is effective upon its Issued Date.
