# INTERIM DECISION VACATING EVIDENTIARY HEARING

### I. STATEMENT

- 1. On July 10, 2024, Dwight Bordelon filed a Complaint against Public Service Company of Colorado ("Respondent" or "Public Service"). That filing commenced this proceeding.
- 2. On July 11, 2024, Rebecca White, Director, served a copy of the Complaint together with an Order requiring the respondent to satisfy or answer said complaint within 20 days, in accordance with § 40-6-108, C.R.S. An evidentiary hearing was scheduled for September 24, 2024.
- 3. On July 31, 2024, the above captioned proceeding was referred by minute entry to an Administrative Law Judge ("ALJ").

4. Also on July 31, 2024, Public Service filed its Motion to Dismiss.

# II. <u>EVIDENTIARY HEARING</u>

- 5. In order to provide sufficient time to consider the Motion to Dismiss, and for the Parties to prepare for a potential hearing, the evidentiary hearing scheduled for September 24, 2024, shall be vacated.
- 6. The evidentiary hearing shall be rescheduled contemporaneously, if necessary, with a ruling on the Motion to Dismiss.

## III. ORDER

### A. It Is Ordered That:

- 1. The evidentiary hearing scheduled for September 24, 2024, is vacated.
- 2. The evidentiary hearing shall be rescheduled contemporaneously, if necessary, with a ruling on the Motion to Dismiss filed by Public Service Company of Colorado on July 31, 2024.
  - 3. This Decision shall be effective immediately.
