To the extent necessary to implement the Settlement Agreement, N-no more than five business days after this Recommended Decision becomes a Commission Decision (if that is the case), Public Service must file compliance advice letter(s) and tariff sheets consistent with the Settlement Agreement, 's and this Decision's requirements, on not less than two business days' notice. The compliance filings must be made in a new advice letter proceeding and comply with all applicable rules.
