

Colorado Board of Real Estate Appraisers
Course and Provider Education Approval Process
(02/12)

Approval of courses and providers for education by the Colorado Board of Real Estate Appraisers requires the use of the Continuing and Qualifying Education Course and Provider Application.

Applications and supporting documentation may be submitted electronically to The Division of Real Estate. It is recommended that all your documentation be submitted in a secure format for your protection. After review and approval (or denial), a letter will be emailed to you notifying you that your course/provider has been approved (or denied). If the course is approved it will be added to our approved course list.

The Appraisal Foundation's Course Approval Program (CAP) must approve all courses delivered in a nontraditional classroom setting, unless exempt per Board Rule 7.23. For more information regarding education requirements we strongly recommend you visit the Appraisal Foundation's website at www.appraisalfoundation.org. It is your responsibility to ensure you are Appraisal Subcommittee (ASC) and Appraiser Qualification Board (AQB) compliant. Secondary course providers you MUST include a copy of the Secondary Course Provider Agreement with your application. Additionally, secondary course providers are responsible for requesting and receiving their own approval from IDECC for their specific course delivery mechanism. The primary course provider's IDECC approval does not transfer. The IDECC Distance Education Certification MUST be included in your application packet.
