On February 20, 2009, the Colorado State Board of Medical Examiners (Colorado Board), issued a Letter of Admonition against your medical license. The Colorado Board found that on or about May 8, 2007, you answered "No" on your license renewal questionnaire when asked "since you last renewed your Colorado medical license, have you been admonished, reprimanded, censured and/or disciplined in any way by any agency in another state or country, by any peer review committee or body, by any health care facility or committee thereof, by any professional or medical society or association or committee thereof, or by any government agency, law enforcement agency or court of law whether involuntary or in lieu of investigation?" You should have answered "Yes" to this question as on April 9, 2007, you entered into a Consent Agreement with the Board of Medical Examiners of the State of Iowa. In addition, the Colorado Board found that you had failed to comply with Rule 270 which required you to update your address of record within 30 days of a change of address. These actions are in violation of California Business and Profession Code sections 141(a), 2234 and 2305.

Pursuant to the authority of the California Business and Professions Code section 2233, you are hereby issued this Public Letter of Reprimand by the Medical Board of California.
